At Copec, we are committed to creating value for the country and its communities, with sustainability as the cornerstone of all our actions. Our vision is to be a benchmark in today's and tomorrow's energy, in convenience, and in mobility, thanks to our passion for service, innovation, and sustainability, which are embedded in our purpose: "We exist to empower the development and movement of people, businesses, and the country". We also uphold the commitments that define us: passion for service, innovation and future vision, excellence and quality, and ethical and responsible conduct.

In line with the commitment set forth in our 2021 Climate Change Declaration, we are working to achieve the goal of becoming a Zero Waste¹ company by 2029 across our operations associated with plants, service stations, convenience stores, distribution centers, and offices.

In this context, the strategies and actions we undertake as a Company include reviewing and improving comprehensive waste management, with the aim of moving towards more sustainable practices, enabling the transition to a circular economy model, and achieving a reduction in waste generation.

To reflect this commitment, we are working on:

Procedures for waste management and diversion:

- Engaging our entire value chain (dealers, employees, subsidiaries, suppliers, and customers) as strategic partners to reach the zero waste target, seeking scalable and sustainable solutions.
- Raising awareness, educating, and training our employees in more sustainable practices that incorporate the principles of circular economy (redesign, reduce, repair, reuse, compost, recycle), with actions at every stage to ensure compliance with our commitment.
- Implementing comprehensive waste management across all our operations, which involves identifying generating sources, segregation, recovery, and traceability.

Procedures for monitoring and performance reporting:

• Following up, monitoring, and analyzing through the establishment of key performance indicators, permanent reporting, and periodic internal reviews, ensuring compliance with environmental regulations.

Copec will drive and oversee the plans and programs, promoting scalable actions to become a Zero Waste company by 2029, ensuring transparency in our implementation.

¹ Includes organic, household, and household-like waste. Excludes hazardous waste and waste related to oils and lubricants, which are regulated through compliance with the targets set by the Extended Producer Responsibility Law (REP Law) and its forthcoming decree for such waste.
